



Fellow SCAPE Members:

To conform with the current guidance from the Federal and State Governments on social distancing, the Association is recommending that you do not conduct any polygraph examinations unless necessary.

If you do have a polygraph examination that you have determined must be conducted, Lafayette has provided some guidelines for how to clean your equipment.

*The Lafayette LX6, LX5000, and LX4000 systems and all accessories may be cleaned with any of the following:*

- *Alcohol wipes*
- *Disinfectant wipes*
- *Damp towel with anti-bacterial soap*

#### *Cautions*

- *Do not use bleach on any part of the polygraph system*
- *Wipe down the surfaces of the equipment only, do not soak or saturate any part of the system with liquid.*
- *Do not use alcohol, disinfectant (disinfectant wipes), or bleach on the rubber O-rings of the cardio or pneumo connectors.*

If you have equipment from another manufacturer and have questions, please contact them directly for specific guidance.
